Self-Immolation or Murder?



The fire on Liu Chunling was put out. Liu was facing the fire extinguisher. A hand can be seen throwing something toward Liu's head.



An object hits Liu's head and then rebounds. Liu was hit so hard that she turned 180 degrees, and her back was toward the fire extinguisher.



The object flies into the crowd and then falls quickly. From the speed of its fall, it is obvious that the object is quite heavy.



A man in a military overcoat stands at the spot where Liu was hit, in a pose suggesting that he just threw something.

The Jiang regime uses the alleged "self-immolation" incident that occurred on Tiananmen Square on January 23, 2001, to defame Falun Gong.

But the IED stated in a report:

Washington Post journalist Phillip Pan went to Liu Chunling's hometown of Kaifeng to investigate the case. Liu's neighbors said that nobody ever saw Liu practice Falun Gong.

When the Chinese Central TV (CCTV) footage is played in slow motion, it is clear that, in the midst of the smoke, someone strikes Liu Chunling's head with an object. Liu immediately collapses. Then the object rebounds and quickly falls down. So who struck Liu? If we freeze the frame, we see someone's arm wave toward Liu's head, and then an armed soldier walks toward the camera. Next to him stands a man in a military overcoat on the spot where Liu was struck, in a position that suggests he just used force to hit something.

In August 2001 during the "self-immolation" show-trial, the footage from Tiananmen Square was rebroadcast in China. All clips that had been previously pointed out as suspicious by the Western media or analysts were cut from the rebroadcast, especially the clip that showed Liu Chunling's collapse—it was completely eliminated. Why were these suspicious clips cut?
